(1) Student Life subsidy is at least €50.- per participant and can be obtained only once during your study time. This amount will be transferred to the applicant after the study trip, when the subsidy has been definitively awarded by Student Life.

(2) BeeVee's subsidy for first-time participation can be obtained if you participate in the BOS study trip for the first time. The amount can range from €50.- to €100.- The eligible participants have to pay €50.- less for the initial amount, the remainder of the subsidy will be transferred to the participant after the study trip.



Terms and conditions

Organisation

- 'Biologen op Stap' (BOS) organizes this study trip to Hungary. This committee is part of BeeVee, Biologists Association Nijmegen.
- This study trip will take place from **Saturday April 27th up to, and including, Sunday May 5th, 2024**. Departure time is to be announced. The arrival time on **Sunday May 5th** is dependent on several factors (travel times, etc.) and can therefore not be guaranteed.

Participation

- This contract is solely valid if the minimum number of 25 participants has been reached. In case of a lower number of participants, this contract will be declared invalid.
- The maximum number of participants is 40. Spots are assigned on a first-come first-served basis.
- At the moment of signing, the participant is a student who is either a member or friend of BeeVee.
- In case the contract is filled in incompletely or in case the required documents (copy of passport/ID card) are not provided together with the contract, the contract will be declared invalid and the participant will be notified. Consequently, the concerning student will not be able to participate in this study trip.
- The registration starts **December 11th, 2023** and closes **December 15th, 2023**.

Travel program and assignments

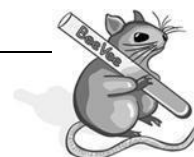
- During this study trip, the participant must engage in all activities organised by BOS.
- It is the participant's responsibility to be present at all agreed locations. Potential costs that arise from being late will be at the concerning participant's expense.



Terms of payment

- The costs of this study trip are €350.-
 - Participants that applied and are eligible for Student Life subsidy will get a refund of at least €50.- after the study trip.
 - The initial costs for participants that applied and are eligible for BeeVee's subsidy for first-time participation are €300.-
- Included in the costs of this study trip are:
 1. Transport from/to Nijmegen to/from Hungary AND within Hungary
 2. 6 overnight stays
 3. At least 1 meal a day
 4. Visits to institutes organised by BOS
 5. Cultural activities
 6. Visit to nature reserves

N.B.: any other costs (food, drinks, etc.) during the trip are on the participant's account.
- The participant has **until December 30th, 2023** to transfer the costs that apply to them to account number NL57INGB0005654482 in the name of BeeVee Biologenvereniging te Nijmegen.
- In case of the payment in terms the participant has to transfer 50% of the corresponding price until **December 30th, 2023**, and the remaining 50% until **January 30th, 2024**.
- Add the following information to your transfer description: BOS trip, your name, type of participation (first-time or not), and the type of payment (full price/1st term/2nd term).
- In case the payment obligation is not fulfilled, the concerning student will not be allowed to participate on this study trip.
- In case any amount of money remains of the revenues, this amount will be divided over the participants and refunded.



Unforeseen circumstances and liability

- If BOS deems necessary, it can cancel the study trip. In this case, the participant will be notified as soon as possible. Paid funds will be restituted after subtracting any costs made on behalf of the participant.
- Potential extra expenses that must be made to facilitate a successful trip can be charged to the participants, if these costs are beyond the fault of the organisation.
- BeeVee is not responsible for potential damage suffered by the participant as a consequence of participating in this study trip. Participation is at one's own risk.
- BeeVee is not responsible for potential damage to third parties caused by the participant.
- In case the participant refrains from participating in this study trip after signing this contract, without the question of force majeure, he/she is not entitled to any restitution of paid funds. Force majeure includes any external disturbance, illness, death and other comparable, unforeseen circumstances. All cancellations will be examined and judged by BOS and the board of BeeVee. Here is stated with emphasis that study, financial obligations and Covid-19 infection or related quarantine do not count as force majeure.
- Any unforeseen and additional Covid-19 related costs are at the expense of the participant.

Alcohol and Drugs policy

- During the entire study trip the participants are obligated to adhere to the Alcohol and Drug policy of BeeVee as can be found on the website of BeeVee.
- BeeVee reserves the right to enact measures both during the trip and afterwards if these policies were not adhered to at any point during the trip. Any such measure has to be discussed by the board and BOS.
- In the case that local laws are stricter than the alcohol and drugs policy of BeeVee, they supersede said policy.



Travel documents and insurance

- The participant must be in possession of the required, valid documents (passport or ID card and Covid-19 vaccination or recovery QR code*) at the time of departure and during the study trip.
- In case the participant cannot engage in (a part of) the study trip due to the lack of a document, any associated consequences are on the concerning participant's account.
- The participant is strongly advised to obtain travel insurance, but this is the participant's responsibility.

Complaints

- Despite all care it is possible that the participant believes they have a justified complaint. This complaint should be expressed to BOS as soon as possible so it can be solved directly, if possible. If the complaint is not solved to their satisfaction, the participant has two months after the end of the study trip to have their complaint handled by an arbitration committee. This committee will be formed on request of the participant and will consist of a representative appointed by the participant, a representative from BOS and a third representative appointed by both parties. This arbitration committee must state a unanimous, binding opinion to the participant and BOS. Within one week after the request of the institution of the arbitration committee, all involved parties must be notified of the constitution of this committee in writing.

*The need for possession of Covid-19-related documents is dependent on the Covid-19 regulations in Hungary at the moment of travelling.

Other

- In all cases in which this contract does not suffice, BOS is entitled to make appropriate decisions.

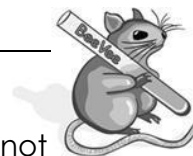
